DELIVERING FOR YOU

Living in Mile End means we are always available so when you tell us an issue or a concern we are straight on it - below are some of the results.

- ✓ Speeding in Mile End reported, police informed of key identified roads and enforcement action carried out in- Bergolt Road, Apprentice Drive, Mill Road and VUR.
- ✓ Dog fouling frequently reported, zone wardens requested to clear up and asked to patrol those areas to catch offenders. If caught it is a Fixed Penalty Notice of £100 enforceable by the courts.
- ✓ Street lighting reported as not working, we chased up with ECC, some repairs completed and we will keep chasing along with reporting and chasing up broken traffic islands!
- ✓ Residents reported areas with litter issues, we asked and got extra bins installed. Mile End has the most bins of any ward in the borough with regular collections by zone wardens. If you believe an area needs a bin please let us know.
- ✓ The worst potholes in Mile End were identified, with 20 potholes put forward by County Councillor Anne Turrell as part of the ECC pothole initiative.

that you believe the police should know about (for example anti-social behaviour or areas where speeding occurs) please report to colchestercommunitypolicingteam@essex.pnn.police.uk

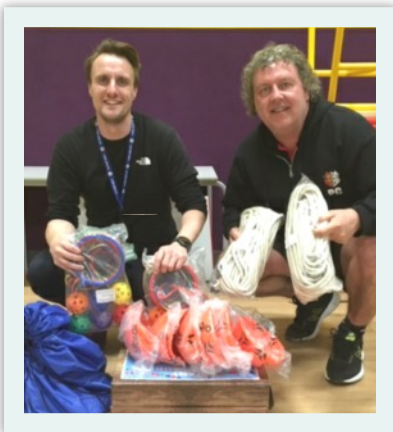
Reports are picked up from this email address and it helps officers build a profile of issues in your community and for deployment of officers.

The Northern Gateway development is nearby and in Mile End, but despite recent consultations and displays it still seems confusing!

Cllr and PE teacher Phil Coleman has been tracking developments. Over the A12, near the BP garage and park and ride will be a fantastic top quality **state of the art sports development** available by the end of this year.

Included will be a new sports hall with coffee shop, outdoor cycling track, new facilities for archery, classrooms for coaching and a new clubhouse with two full size floodlit all weather pitches and grass pitches for rugby.
